LIGHTNING SAFETY NOTICE

Stay Safe During Thunderstorms & Lightning

Your safety is our priority! Here are some essential tips to keep you and your family safe:

Before a Thunderstorm:

- Build an emergency kit and create a family communication plan.
- Secure outdoor items that might blow away.
- Postpone outdoor activities and head indoors to a sturdy building or hard-top vehicle.
- Unplug electronic devices to protect them from power surges.

During the Storm:

- Stay indoors! Avoid windows, doors, and exterior walls.
- Don't shower, wash hands, or do laundry—lightning can travel through a building's plumbing.
- Unplug devices and avoid corded phones. Use surge protectors.
- Bring pets indoors and supervise them closely.

If someone is struck by lightning, call 911 immediately. Be aware of continued lightning danger to both the victim and the rescuer.
