COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Winter Prep Reminder: As cold weather approaches, please disconnect your garden hoses and shut off water to outdoor spigots from the basement. Frozen pipes can cause damage, and per our Community Guidelines, residents may be held responsible. If you need help turning off the water, please let us know. We are happy to assist!

Avoid Costly Repairs: Leaving hoses attached can lead to pipe damage. Spigot replacements typically cost around \$150, so please take action now to avoid unnecessary charges.

Holiday Travel: If you'll be away for more than a few days, notify us so we can keep an eye on your home. We also recommend shutting off your water to prevent leaks or damage while you're gone. Assistance is available if needed.

Fireplace Use: Your fireplace is functional but not a primary heat source. It uses natural gas, which will reflect on your utility bill. Always turn it off when leaving the room or your home. If you have trouble lighting it, we can submit a work order for repair.
