MAINTENANCE TIPS

- Know where your shut-off valve is. In case of a plumbing emergency, quick action can prevent damage.



Energy-Saving Tips:

- Set your thermostat wisely. A steady temperature is more efficient than frequent adjustments.
- Use rugs on bare floors. They help insulate and keep rooms feeling warmer.
- Report heating issues early. If something doesn't feel right, maintenance can address it before it becomes a bigger problem.
